

## **NF IIIA CAR REGULATION**

**Enforced on February 10, 2007**

**Amended on March 5, 2007**

Japanese Formula 3 car shall conform to the Formula 3 Technical Regulation of Appendix J either to the International Sporting Code 2007 Regulation or up to the International Sporting Code 2004 Regulations and the following items :

- 1) Cars must use Bridgestone tyres designated by NF IIIA at any official events such as official tests, free practice sessions, qualifying sessions and final races.
- 2) A driver is permitted to use up to 4 front and 4 rear tyres during any race weekend from the beginning of qualifying to the end of final race (or to the end of race 2 in case of 2 races during one weekend). Brand new tyres to be used for any race weekend (from free practice session to the end of the last race of the weekend) must be tyres supplied by Bridgestone exclusively for the race weekend, provided, however, that brand new tyres that were not used during the previous race weekend or in the previous official test are not considered brand new ones in the free practice session.
  - \* During any race weekend with 3 races a driver is permitted to use up to 6 front and 6 rear tyres.
- 3) Modifications on tyres such as grooving on dry tyres or re-grooving on rain tyres are not permitted in any way.
- 4) Intentional modifications on tyres before outing are not permitted in any way.
