

NF III A – ENTRY REGULATION

Enforced on February 10, 2006

Amended on March 5, 2007

Valid from 3/1/07 to 10/21/07

Nippon Formula 3 Association

Article 1. registration procedures

Once a competitor or driver completes registration of their names with JAF (Japan Automobile Federation) as a license holder they shall fill in a designated application form, place a seal and turn it in to Nippon Formula 3 Association (referred to as "NF III A" hereafter) by Tuesday February 28, 2007. Entry fee shall also be paid by the day to the following bank account.

Article 2. Definitions

- 1) Registered entrants : signify both registered drivers and registered competitors (teams)
- 2) This regulation shall be valid from March 1, 2007 to October 21, 2007
- 3) Race week : a relevant week comprising Friday, Saturday and Sunday in which a race or races are held
- 4) Competition : a 2-days race event on Saturday and Sunday held by each event promoter
- 5) Tyre tickets : tyre coupons issued and sold by NF III A to entrants
- 6) Private test : track test except for official tests

Article 3. Entries for race

Once entrants complete their registration their entries for each race event are considered to have been completed, provided that, for any competitions where mutual aid funds or insurance are payable entrants shall follow necessary procedures designated by promoters of each competition. Entrants shall advise promoters of each competition if the entrants cannot participate in the competition.

Article 4. Supply of annual pass

Each registered entrant shall be supplied with 8 annual passes in principle for its driver, representative of the entrant and its pit crews. One more pass for a pit crew shall be supplied to any entrant who runs more than one car in the championship for every additional car.

Article 5. Restrictions on use of tyres

- 1) Registered entrants are subject to Restrictions on use of tyres.

- 2) Registered entrants are permitted to purchase up to 41 sets of brand new dry tyres during the term of this regulation.
- 3) Any dry tyres shall be supplied marked "07" by Bridgestone. No other tyres are permitted to use, in principle.
- 4) Any F3 tyres manufactured by Bridgestone may be used in the official test before the opening round for 2007 season even if such tyres are not marked "07".
- 5) Any unused tyre tickets for 2006 may be used to obtain "07" marked tyres until March 14, 2007.
- 6) Any registered entrants who complete registration after the first official test are permitted to use 41 sets less number of days for any finished official test(s) and race week(s) before the registration.
- 7) Up to 3 sets of brand new dry tires may be obtained for tire tickets per race week. Entrants must purchase such tyres from Bridgestone's service garage set up in each competition. Such tyres shall be marked "07" and number of the relevant round.
- 8) Entrants are permitted to use only dry tyres obtained from Bridgestone's service garage set up at the relevant competition.
- 9) During the term of this regulation only tyres obtained for tire tickets allocated to each entrant are permitted to be used for any official tests after the opening session, private tests and race weeks except for private tests for which entrants can purchase and use any other makes than Bridgestone tyres.
- 10) Violation of any of the above clauses shall be subject to the Article 12.

Article 6. Sales of tyre tickets

NFⅢA shall sell tyre tickets. Rain tyres require other tickets (there is no limit on the number of rain tyres that can be used). In principle, entrants shall make payments for tyre tickets to the following bank account before placing orders for them by email or fax. Entrants may purchase tyre tickets directly from NFⅢA, who attend to any official program preparing for unforeseeable circumstances.

* Tyre tickets shall be available for sales from March 1 to October 21, 2007.

Article 7. Participation in official tests or Friday's free practice sessions

Registered entrants may participate in any official tests organized by NFⅢA and practices on the previous day of any competition. In order to participate in such tests or practices registered entrants must meet the following requirements. Otherwise registered entrants may be imposed penalties :

- 1) Registered entrants who are going to participate any official tests or Friday's free practice sessions where a certain track is used exclusively by the session participants must sign a pledge designated by NF III A. Neither non registered drivers or entrants are permitted to participate in such tests or practices.
- 2) Pit lane is limited to 60km/h.
- 3) Registered drivers who bring about 2 red flag interventions in one session (1 – 3 hours) may not run in the session.
- 4) Pit garages shall be assigned by NF III A for each participant.
- 5) NF III A shall distribute copy of results.
- 6) Only drivers who are going participate in a competition are permitted to the relevant Friday's free practice session.
- 7) Private tests may be held at a track no later than 60 days before a competition to be held at the track.
- 8) Violation of any of the above clauses shall be subject to the Article 12.

Article 8. Pit garage for competition

If pit garages are assigned to F3 championship by event promoter registered entrants have priority to non registered entrants for using the pit garages. However, the number of garages assigned to F3 championship is less than the number of registered entrants those registered entrants who finish high in the previous competition shall have priorities (in case of opening race ranking in the previous year shall be considered).

NF III A shall assign pit garages in consideration of entrants' requests and progress of competition. If garages are not assigned to every entrant NF III A may make sure of one pit garage for any entrants who are not assigned with pit garages to use it as a passage way into the track.

Article 9. Taking pictures

Any photos or images of registered entrants shall be used for public relations of Japanese F3 Championship. Registered entrants shall help NF III A take pictures. Any photos owned by NF III A may be provided to relevant drivers or entrants for free upon request.

Portrait rights of teams or drivers shall be lent to NF III A.

Article 10. Requests or suggestions

Registered entrants may make request or suggestions to NF III A as an entrant.

Article 11. Championship Prizes

Registered entrants will be awarded at an awarding ceremony at the end of the series.

● Rookie of the year

¥500,000 (tax of ¥23,810 included) and a trophy will be awarded to a Formula 3 rookie who has been most successful in the championship

● Best mechanic of the year

A trophy will be awarded to a chief mechanic of a team which 2007 champion drives for.

● Engine tuner of the year

A trophy will be awarded to a tuner of an engine used by 2007 champion.

Article 12. Observance of the Regulations

Registered entrants must be aware that NFⅢA may impose penalties to any violation of NFⅢA General Regulation, Entry Regulation or Car regulation, or any conducts prejudicial to promotions or development Formula 3.

Article 13

Any issues not provided in this Regulation shall be discussed at NFⅢA Board of Directors meeting, where this Regulation may be added or amended, if necessary.
